awarded to RHS student(s) that have made a significant positive turnaround

Instructions

- **On a separate single page,** list your activities, achievements and years involved in the following categories: Honors Achieved and Awards won, Offices and Positions of Leadership held, Membership of Organization and Community Service, (please list hours and contacts for verification) Some emphasis will be place on experience in speech, debate, knowledge bowl activities and how these will help you with your future endeavors. (Minimum font size, 10, Minimum margins, 1 inch)
- **On a separate single page** write a brief statement of your career and/or educational goals. Discuss how you plan to achieve your goals and how you plan to contribute to the community in the future. On the same page you may write a brief statement of any financial circumstances that should be considered when reviewing your scholarship application. (Minimum font size, 10, Minimum margin, 1 inch)
- **Attach a copy** of your official high school transcript in a sealed envelope.
- **Attach two letters of recommendation.** One letter must be from an instructor or counselor who will attest to your academic achievements. The second letter shall be from a community member (employer, coach, pastor, etc.) who will speak of your character and describe and attest to your achievement in service and citizenship.

Additional Scholarship opportunity

- **Robert Hyatt Spudder Spirit Scholarship:** Include the above requirements and attach up to a two-hundred word essay on Spudder Spirit – “What does Spudder Spirit mean to you?”
- **Burkle Family Scholarships:** Scholarship of \$2,000 awarded to students that really need the support in order to attend college or technical school.
- **Adkins Family Scholarship:** Scholarship of \$2,000 awarded to a student who is pursuing a vocational trade school or technical school education.
- **Starfish Scholarship:** Include the above requirements and attach up to a three-hundred word essay on – “How they have made a difference in their community.” Scholarship(s) of \$1,000.
- **Turnaround Scholarship(s):** made a significant turnaround during their time at RHS. {Counselor recommended}

Complete Scholarship application and include all contact information.

Online applications are the preferred method of submission. If this doesn't work for you, you may complete the paper copy.
